Little Dancer Arrives in Fox Point

On August 11, the Fox Point Village Board approved the installation of Richard Edelman's sculpture, Little Dancer, Aged 14, at the southwest corner of North Lake

Drive and East Bradley Road. The sculpture is scheduled for installation in early fall 2020.

The sculpture is Edelman's gift to Fox Point in the form of a three year, no-cost-to-the-village, renewable loan.

Edelman grew up in Fox Point and lives here today. He graduated the Fox Point School in 1962, Nicolet High School in 1966, and Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) in 1970. He is an internationally recognized artist with pieces displayed as near as Congregation Shalom on Santa Monica



Boulevard, the west side of the Jewish Community Center in Whitefish Bay, and at the Boerner Botanical Gardens, and as far afield as Egg Harbor (Wisconsin), Jerusalem and Be'er Sheva (Israel), and Krakow (Poland).

Little Dancer is the first piece of public art on village property.

The sculpture is inspired by, and a direct reference, to the eponymous 1881 sculpture by the French artist Edgar Degas.

We are fortunate to have a piece of public art by an artist of Edelman's stature. We invite the public to visit and enjoy Little Dancer, Aged 14.
