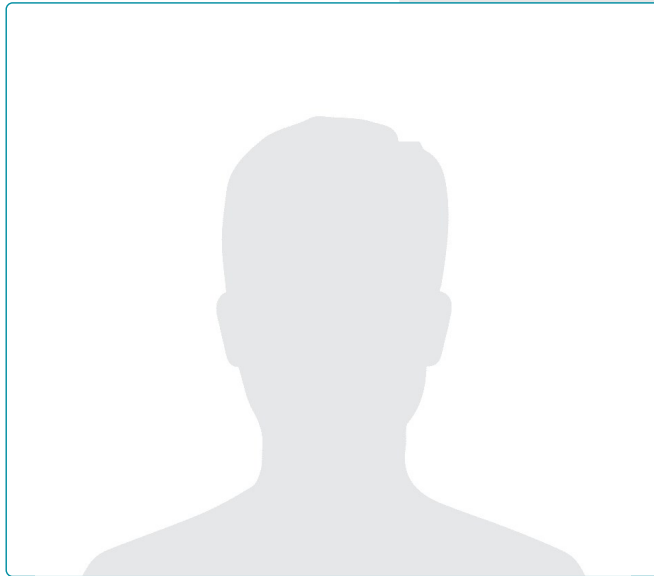

As a member of the association, she competed in a National Moot Court Competition hosted by the UCLA Williams Institute. Separately, she advanced to the quarterfinals of Marquette's Jenkins Honors Moot Court Competition. Isabella received CALI Awards in Legal Research & Writing and Law Governing Lawyers and was inducted into the Pro Bono Honor Society.
